

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

In the fall of 2012, CAF changed its membership structure so that there are only two types of members: Individual (1 vote) and Family (2 votes). In addition, the membership program was also changed from a calendar year, to a 12 month period.

Individual Member (\$35)
