**Position Title:** Membership & Merchandise Sales Assistant Volunteer

**Dates and Times Needed:** Saturday, July 8<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup> for three-hour shifts between 7:30AM and 7:00PM. A mandatory Volunteer Orientation is held at Edgewater Park on Thursday, July 6<sup>th</sup> at 6:00-7:00PM to orient volunteers to the festival layout, provide important information, and answer questions.

**Description:** Want to be involved in one of Skagit County's favorite summer family festivals? Volunteer to assist with Membership & Merchandise Sales Skagit Valley Highland Games! Volunteers will assist with restocking and sales of Skagit Valley Highland Games & Celtic Arts Foundation merchandise, including credit card processing and cash handling. Volunteers will process memberships, including assisting with form completion and processing payments.

**Skills & Requirements:** Volunteers should be able to stand comfortably for at least three hours. Volunteers should be comfortable and qualified for payment processing, including operating credit card technology and correctly counting change. Volunteers should have strong organizational, guest services, and math skills.

**Volunteer Expectations:** Volunteers should be able to provide excellent guest services and have a generally positive demeanor, including smiling, welcoming guests, and answering questions. Volunteers should be comfortable interacting with the public and answering questions (the Celtic Arts Foundation Merchandise Tent is frequently a first stop for many guests).

**Volunteer Benefits:** Individuals who volunteer for a three-hour shift are provided with a free Family Weekend Pass (valid for four people) to the Skagit Valley Highland Games.

**Supervisor:** Check in with Lindsay Van Houten, Celtic Arts Foundation Program & Event Manager, at the Volunteer Tent ten minutes before the beginning of volunteer shift. Training provided by Kayalyn Stewart, Celtic Arts Foundation Merchandise Tent Coordinator.
