There are four steps to registration. At the bottom of each page, you will find a hyperlink to continue to the next step. **As you will see explained on Step 1, it is important that you do NOT select “Proceed to Registration” after adding tickets to your cart until you are on the final step, Step 4.** Please be sure to read the information on all four pages—many of your questions will be answered there! Step 1: Housing & Dining

This page contains:

- Instructions on how to complete the registration process

- The schedule for Highland Pipes & Drums and Smallpipes & Fiddles, including meals

Tickets you are **required** to add to your cart:

- Appropriate session and housing selection (ex: Pipes & Drums, 5-Day Session, Shared Room)
- Chaperone selection *for students under 16*

Tickets that are **optional** to add to your cart:

- Chaperone selections for students over 16
- Early Arrival for Pipes & Drums
- Additional MSA tickets

Step 2: Merchandise

This page contains:

- A reminder that shirts and hoodies **must** be pre-purchased: no extras will be available on-site
- A description of available merchandise

Tickets that are **required** to add to your cart:

- None: The Winter School music book is included in the cost of tuition

Tickets that are **optional** to add to your cart:

- Long sleeve shirt
- Hoodie
- CAF baseball hat
- CAF mug
- CAF pin
- Winter School blend coffee

Step 3: Transportation

Tickets that are **required** to add to your cart:

Tickets that are **optional** to add to your cart:
